Espaliers with low yields, no more than 6000 Kg / Ha. The soil is of alluvial Vineyard Structure

origin with a high percentage of stone and sandy-loam areas.

Grape Selection Grapes harvested by hand in 13 Kg boxes

> Once harvested, the grape was macerated and fermented in 220 liter French Elaboration, oak barrels. Then, the wine was aged for 18 months in the first use French

> Fermentation, Storage oak barrels, and then bottled -- horizontally -- and stowed for 5 years.

A wine with great complexity and intensity. Plums and blackberry are Aroma

intertwined with notes of chocolate and vanilla. Sweet finishes in the nose,

especially candy.

A strong wine without losing fluidity in the mouth. Blackberry jam fruit Flavor

flavors and hints of wood. Long finish with pure aromas of fresh fruit.

It can be drunk now, or saved for later.
